This year, the Foundation has given **39 scholarships to 25 students (7 college students and 18 high school students) for a total of \$33,650**, our highest total ever.

To date, the Foundation has given a total of \$127,734 in Teacher Grants and \$342,950 in scholarships to Cumberland High School graduates. Grand total of Foundation giving: \$470,684.

This could not have been possible without the generosity of all of the donors who annually give for this purpose recognizing the importance of an education beyond high school.

In addition to the donors, Cumberland County citizens and surrounding counties have shown a commitment to this cause as well by participating in the several activities held during each year, such as the Annual 5K Run and the Walk for Education which raises funds for Grants for Teachers. We plan to add a Class Reunion function to that as well as additional ideas discussed at our upcoming summer retreat. The leadership of the Foundation also play an important role in organizing and carryout these activities on a volunteer basis.

We also recognize our new scholarships this year, the Superintendent's Scholarship and the Homeland Security Anonymous Scholarship as well as the additional of another \$1,000 scholarship added to the \$4,000 annually received by the Cumberland Clothes Closet, our largest annual donor.
